
We're keeping down the cost of living

We're cleaning up Barnet's streets




We brought back free community skips and food waste recycling, and are cracking down on fly-tipping.

We're keeping you and your family safe




We have fixed our CCTV - broken 70 per cent of the time under the Conservatives and now deploy mobile CCTV units.

Fixing Our Roads




We fixed 50% more potholes than the Conservatives and investing £97m in upgrading streets and pavements.
